ERNEST GODIN RESUME

Ernest has had a career as a sociologist and practicing psychologist, all the while working in related fields in the TV industry, as a researcher and host for organizations such as Télé-Québec, CBC/Radio-Canada and the National Film Board. A partner and co-founder of Kondololé Films since November 2002, Godin has been involved with media for over 25 years.

His screen credits include work as a writer, researcher and host. He worked with CBC French Radio as a host, and Télé-Québec, as on-air **host and researcher** for the popular 52-episode **docudrama** series *C'est la Vie* (1990), with Marcel Sabourin.

Also in the 1990s Godin worked at the NFB with Anne-Claire Poirier, as a researcher.

In the days when multimedia production was still in its infancy, he founded Pandora Productions, a new media company that developed content for the Web and PCs. He later sold Pandora to CineGroupe, becoming CEO and **executive producer** of CineGroupe Interactive, where he was involved in many successful projects including *Sagwa the Chinese Siamese Cat*, co-produced for PBS with Sesame Workshop. He has also been an **associate professor** of New Media at Quebec's Institut National de l'Image et du Son (INIS), and from 2000 through 2005 mentored for the Interactive Project Lab (IPL), designed and managed by the Banff New Media Institute, the Canadian Film Centre and INIS.
